



Romsey Town Mayors 1883 to date (March 2010)

The main list is taken from the board in Romsey Town Hall Council Chamber. Where other sources suggest a missing entry or an alternative name/spelling, this is shown beside the name entry. The most common of these other sources is Dr John Latham (1740-1837), the first local historian in Romsey. The earliest references are mostly gleaned from details of witnesses to deeds held in the Winchester College Muniments.

Post 1607 Charter of incorporation of Romsey Borough

Note: When more than one person is found in the same year, this sometimes indicates that those who held the position either side of the mayoral year (originally running from Michaelmas to Michaelmas, i.e. 29 September to 29 September). Very occasionally, it is a case of replacement in the event of death or illness. Often, however, no explanation is offered, other than one source or another being completely wrong.
