FOOTNOTE ON GIVING A MAP GRID REFERENCE. A grid ref of the middle point of the site would be very helpful in identifying a site unambiguously. On an Ordnance Survey map identify the vertical grid line number to the immediate left of the point (numbers along the top and bottom of the map). E.g. Romsey Abbey is 35. Then estimate how many tenths your point is between this line and that to its immediate right. Romsey Abbey is 1 tenth, so the grid ref. is 351. Repeat by identifying the horizontal line immediately below your point and go through the same process using the numbers on the left or right edge of the map; so the second part of Romsey Abbey's grid ref. is 212, giving a full grid reference for Romsey Abbey of 351212.
